## Street Proofing Your Kids

Keeping children safe is everyone's responsibility. Lessons in safety should be reinforced by parents.

### Street Proofing Tips:

1. Effective \_\_\_\_\_ begins at home.
2. Teach children \_\_\_\_\_.
3. Encourage them not to play \_\_\_\_\_ in public but to stay within sight.

11. Never give an infant to anyone that is not known well to hold or watch.
12. Never leave a child under the age of \_\_\_\_ unattended.
13. Never leave a child under the age of \_\_\_\_ unattended overnight.
14. Know where your children are at all times.
15. Be cautious of persons asking to take \_\_\_\_\_ of your child.
16. Don't post \_\_\_\_\_ pictures.
17. Promise your children, you will never leave them.
18. Assure your child they will be told directly if a family member or friend dies.
19. Assure your child that if they are missing you won't stop looking for

### Tips for Keeping Kids Safe:

1. Safety in numbers.
2. Safe touching
3. Use a broad brush for predators.
4. No secrets. Period.
5. Identify a 'safety zone' person.
6. Teach correct terms for body parts.
7. Role play and practice 'what if' scenarios.
8. Respect privacy of others.
9. Express affection on their own.
10. NO means NO.
